ARX Rallycross Information

Thank you for taking the time to join us for ARX rallycross. This is a very different type of event that many of you have worked. This document along with the other attached documentation will help prepare you for this event.

As with any new event we work, please be patient and flexible as the weekend progresses as things may change with out notice.

The purpose of this document is to give a base line of what will be expected from flagger, starter and start line marshals. Information about Race Control Communicator and Secretary are contained in the document

Flag Marshals (Flag Chief: Bill Armitage)

These are the baseline flag rules we will follow for the weekend. Adjustments may occur and will be discussed in the morning meetings

There will not be any response on track at any time unless granted permission.

A track map is attached with station locations and names/numbers which will be the identifiers for control. Ignore the green dots that are the identifiers, use the handwritten markings as the locations.
