

Honda Indy 200 Pre-Race Info

Thank you for taking time to participate for the Honda Indy200 weekend. We appreciate the time you are taking to come join us for a full weekend of IndyCar action. The schedule while busy is not your typical IndyCar schedule with some longer breaks in between sessions.

We have been working with Mid-Ohio closely on procedures and protocols for the event. As with everything going on currently, this information is subject to change. If something does change, the updated information will be posted on the website and the LEC Facebook page. Please be patient and understanding as we navigate through this process.

There will be a lot of eyes on this event and if we want to continue racing, we ask that you follow the procedures and protocols that will be asked of everyone to follow. If you are uncomfortable at being at the track, we do understand and ask that you stay home. We are doing our best to make this easy as possible and to make this an enjoyable weekend to hopefully forget about everything going on.

Please read this document thoroughly and completely. There is a lot of information contained in this document on what to expect for the weekend.

LEC Flag Marshal COVID-19 Guidelines

Prior to arrival please review the attached LEC Guidelines for COVID-19. The document is attached as part of this email.

Entering the Facility

Allow extra time to get through the registration and facility entry process. If you are running late, we understand.

Registration Times:

Thursday: 6:45 AM-7:00 PM

Friday: 6:45 AM-7:00 PM

Saturday: 6:45 AM-5:00 PM

Sunday: 6:45 AM-1:00 PM

Registration will be inside Gate 3 at the Registration Building.

Prior arrival, complete the attached Mid-Ohio COVID-19 questionnaire and Mid-Ohio Waiver. There WILL NOT be any extras at the Registration Building

Only those names that have registered will be permitted on the grounds.

Entering the Facility cont.

Your temperature will be checked every time you enter the facility. If your temperature is 100.4 or higher, you will not be permitted on the grounds. If you are riding in the same car, if a person registers above the temperature, no one in the vehicle will be allowed to enter.

Paddock Area

Will be closed to spectators and marshals. Only essential personnel will be permitted in the Paddock areas. Please **DO NOT** attempt to gain access to the paddock.

Guests

NO GUESTS PASSES WILL BE AVAILABLE

Camping

Camping **WILL BE permitted** in the worker campgrounds. Please keep campsites at least 6 feet apart.

LEC will have an area roped off for our workers in the campground.

The bathrooms and showers by maintenance will be **OPEN**.

Masks and other Face Coverings

Masks and Other Face Coverings **WILL BE REQUIRED** while on Mid-Ohio grounds. However, when on the hot side of the spectator fence in your immediate working area, masks are **HIGHLY RECOMMENDED** to be worn but not required. If you leave your immediate working area, you are **REQUIRED** to wear a mask or face covering. **This policy could change at any time during the weekend.**

If you have permission to respond to an incident even on the cold side of the fence or go on track for any reason, you are REQUIRED to wear a mask or face covering, this includes an incident that may be in front of your immediate working area.

Immediate working area is defined as your flagging position or flag hole up to 10 feet away from the flag position or flag hole on the cold side of the track.

Bring your own mask or face coverings.

Morning Meetings

Morning meeting times will be at:

- Friday: 7:15 AM
- Saturday: 7:15 AM
- Sunday: 7:45 AM

Morning Meetings cont.

Meetings will be in the LEC camping area. If you are not camping, we ask that you park in the grass in front of the seasonal campers across from the former location of the Honda Pavilion.

For those new to Mid-Ohio, the location of the LEC area is attached.

During the meeting we ask that you distance yourself from each other as required.

Water/Gatorade

There **WILL NOT** be any community coolers on station or in the LEC area. You will need to supply your own cooler.

LEC will provide water and Gatorade only. No other beverages will be supplied. We will leave water and Gatorade out for you to take with you. We will have a golf cart circulating during the day to replenish, if needed. Water and Gatorade will be delivered with lunch as well.

LEC will provide ice for your personal, on-station cooler each morning before the meeting.

If you run short of water/Gatorade, call Race Control.

Weekend Schedule and Flag Rules

Is attached in the email. Please review the attached IndyCar marshalling guidelines. These will be followed for each series during the weekend.

Getting to Station

You will be permitted to drive to station each day. We ask that you drive out in one vehicle, however if you are uncomfortable with doing so, you can drive your own vehicle out. There will be designated areas to park for each station. There is an attached map of where each station is to park. Some stations, you may have to walk a little bit to get to your station.

Since spectators will be permitted, be cognizant of the location where you park your car to avoid blocking sightlines or traffic flow.

On Station

We ask that you social distance the best as you can. We do realize there may be a slight delay in displaying the appropriate flag because of it. Some stations are better than others but do the best that you can.

There will be disinfectants on each station. If exchanging equipment, please clean the equipment especially the land line equipment. We also ask that you clean the equipment at the end of each day.

There will also be a small bottle of hand sanitizer in each station bag.

Lunches

We will be providing lunches each day. Lunches will be delivered via golf cart.

Feeling Sick?

If feeling sick prior to arrival....please stay home.

Feeling sick while on-site...contact Race Control immediately, gather your gear and distance yourself from your team. Please wait and the flag chief will pick you up. Depending on symptoms, you may be asked to leave the facility or be taken to medical.

Social Media

We do encourage picture taking while off duty when at events and sharing it with our friends on social media; but with the sensitive nature of our current times and this event, we ask that you be cognizant of what you post. **The requirement by Mid-Ohio is to be wearing a mask on site and be properly distancing in groups.**

For example, if you take a picture of your team on station, make sure everyone is wearing a mask and separated or don't post it.

Common sense is a must in this scenario, the last thing we want is to call attention to ourselves for not following the rules during a large, high profile event which will likely be one of the largest sporting events to date in 2020 in Ohio. By drawing attention to ourselves for the wrong reasons could result in the racing season being shut down not only for Mid-Ohio but for IndyCar and other series. **Do not be the one that ruins it for everyone else.**

End of Day

As marshals, we do like to socialize at the end of the day, sit back and relax reliving the day at hand. However, we are asking that end of the day socialization be kept to a minimum and leave the grounds in a timely manner unless you are camping. If you are camping and are socializing, please keep distancing protocols in mind.

There will not be any worker parties or food provided. You are on your own for evening meals.
